DESCRIPTION/RESPONSIBILITIES:

The individual will be part of the Capital Markets Group of Prudential Annuities, which is responsible for the day to day management and oversight of Prudential's variable annuity hedging program. This involves analysis of key asset and liability risk measures and decision making relative to the management of these risks. Prudential Annuities is currently exploring a new business initiative requiring an experienced risk management professional. The successful candidate would assume a leadership role in supporting the initial viability analysis which centers upon the evaluation of this business model from a valuation and hedging perspective. Following the viability analysis, the candidate would lead in the development, execution and ongoing risk management related to the new business.

The candidate will report directly to the Managing Director of the Capital Markets Group and will lead a small team to manage the risks associated with this initiative. As part of the Annuity Hedging team, the candidate will create and present hedging and risk management related topics to internal and external committees.

REQUIRED SKILLS:

- FSA and CFA/FRM preferred with 7-10 years of risk management experience and leading people
- Prior variable annuity and/or hedging experience is desired
- Strong communication and presentation skills
- Must be able to work equally well independently and in a team environment
- Strong quantitative and analytical skills
- Must be willing to quickly develop in-depth knowledge of annuity product designs and optional benefit features
