“Risk Management and Governance Lessons from the Financial Crisis - The many reports published in the wake of the financial crisis have identified numerous causes of the crisis that often include failures of risk management and corporate governance mechanisms along with failures by regulators and policy-makers. This presentation, which focuses on risk management and corporate governance mechanisms, summarizes some of these findings and argues that many of the changes either proposed or implemented so far sidestep the most fundamental problems and the most difficult remedies. These are the incentives sustained and the externalities created by a large and highly profitable financial sector.
